Constitutional Convention Delegate Election

Tuesday, April 13, 2010

[One-Day Election]

The 35th Constitutional Convention of the International Union, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America, UAW will be held in Detroit, Michigan – June 13-17, 2010.

The number of delegates for Allison Transmission, Inc./Speedway Unit and Ryder Integrated Logistics Unit (combined), based on per capita supplied by the International Union, UAW, is four (4) eligible for election, plus one alternate delegate.

All acceptance letters must be mailed, via U.S. Postal System, **CERTIFIED OR REGISTERED MAIL – RETURN RECEIPT REQUESTED**. Time period for mailing acceptance letters begins **Monday, March 8, 2010 and ends 11:59 p.m., Monday, March 15, 2010**. All acceptance letters must be **postmarked during this time period**. Any acceptance letter mailed **before or after** acceptance letter time limits will be deemed ineligible to run. Only one (1) acceptance letter per mailed envelope.

Absentee ballots will be made available for Ryder Integrated Logistics Unit employees, eligible to vote, not residing in Indiana, per International Union, UAW Constitution, Article 38, Section 10(b), upon written request to the **Chairperson of the Election Committee**. Request must be mailed, via U.S. Postal System, **Certified or Registered Mail-Return Receipt Requested**, addressed to: Chairperson/Election Committee, 2320 S. Tibbs Ave., Indianapolis, IN 46241-4801. **Request for absentee ballot must be postmarked and received by 11:59 p.m. March 19, 2010. ONLY ONE (1) REQUEST FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT PER MAILED ENVELOPE.**

All candidates must be a member in good standing for one (1) year prior to election. Please have your union card on Election Day. Election conducted per the provisions of the International Union, UAW Constitution, Local 933 Bylaws and Local 933 Election Committee. The term of office shall be effective upon completion of 04-13-2010 election until the announcement of 36th Constitutional Convention of International Union, UAW in 2014.

In the event of a tie, a run-off election will be held **Thursday, April 20, 2010**, same polling sites and hours.
