## PLANT 12 EMPLOYEES

As a reminder to employees working in Plant 12 who experienced the one-week layoff during the week of June 7-11, 2010, if you have **not** filed your weekly voucher, **you must do so within 21 days of the unemployment.** One way to complete your weekly voucher is to go online to the State Unemployment Website and sign into your homepage where at the bottom of the page you will see "**file weekly claim/reopen claim**". Click on "**file weekly claim**" and it will take you to the questions you need to answer for your voucher. Please **use 06.12.2010 as the date ending** for this period of unemployment and answer all questions before sending or submitting the claim. Once the claim is submitted, you will be given a confirmation number to keep for your records, which will confirm your "**waiting week**." This will complete the layoff procedure. ## INDEPENDENCE WEEK/VACATION WEEK SHUTDOWN

Pursuant to Para. 202 of our Collective Bargaining Agreement, Allison Transmission will observe a one-week Independence Week Shutdown (IWS – July 5-9, 2010) and a one-week Vacation Shutdown Week (VSW – July 12-16, 2010), **except those scheduled to work as previously notified.** Relative to absence coding during these periods of shutdown, the following will apply: **Employees hired before Feb. 1, 2008** qualify for IWS pay and, if not scheduled to work during this IWS period, will be coded "IWPD". Those who are not scheduled to work during the VWS period will be coded for earned vacation time or flexible holidays. **Employees hired after Feb. 1, 2008** who are not scheduled to work IWS **and/or** VSW will be coded for earned vacation time. Once all earned time off is exhausted, other than "vacation restricted" (VR), employees will be granted unpaid leave for this period of shutdown, which will **not** count toward the attendance policy. In other words, your VR time will not be taken.
